The following are opportunities for Mental Health Professionals (Psychiatrist, LCSW, LCPC, Clinical Psychologist) that are licensed in Illinois. Volunteer Psychiatrists:

- ❖ Seeking licensed Psychiatrists to provide consultations, psychiatric evaluations, and conduct one-on-one patient visits
- ❖ Commitment of 2 times per month for one year
- ❖ Psychiatrists will work in collaboration with the Coordinator of Social Services and the Northwestern University student-run Psychiatry clinic

Experienced LCSW:

- ❖ Seeking experienced LCSWs to provide clinical consultation and support with procedural implementation to the Coordinator of Social Services
- ❖ Commitment is flexible
- ❖ Volunteering can be on-site at the clinic or remotely
- ❖ Volunteer tasks include assistance with formulating policies such as mandatory reporting, confidentiality, domestic violence, etc.

Volunteer Counselors (LCSW, LCPC, Clinical Psychologist)

- ❖ Volunteer counselors needed to provide short term therapy (6 – 12 sessions) in one on one counseling sessions to patients referred to and with interest in receiving counseling services at CommunityHealth
- ❖ Commitment is twice a month for one year
- ❖ Bi-lingual Spanish or Polish is a PLUS
