

Dental Volunteer Opportunities

Volunteer dental providers and assistants are vital to our success in providing quality healthcare to our patients. Scheduling is flexible and providers can commit to as little as one, 4-hour shift per month. Dental assistants are asked to commit to two, 4-hour shifts per month. Scheduling is flexible.

Dentists

Dentists have the opportunity to provide general care (exams, fillings, extractions and preventive care) to our patients. Dentists must have a valid Illinois license.

Dental Hygienists

Dental hygienists have the opportunity to provide scaling root planning (SCRIP) and dental health education. Hygienists must have a valid Illinois license.

Volunteer Dental Assistants

Dental assistants have the opportunity to assist with general dental services (x-rays, instrument preparation, etc). Certification preferred but applicants will be considered who have completed an accredited dental assistant course or have considerable experience.
